- ◆ “Active component of the United States Armed Forces” means active duty services in the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or the Coast Guard. §59-10-1027(1)(a)
- ◆ The reserve components of the armed forces are Army National Guard of the US, Army Reserve, Navy Reserve, Marine Corps Reserve, Air National Guard of the US, Air Force Reserve and the Coast Guard Reserve. 10 U.S.C. §10101
- ◆ “Qualifying active duty period military service” means: §59-2-1901(8)
 - At least 200 days in a continuous 365-day period, regardless of whether consecutive, of active duty military service **outside** the state in an active component of the US Armed Forces or a reserve component of the US Armed Forces and have not previously been counted for the purpose of qualifying for the exemption.
- ◆ Application must be filed in the **year after the year** during which claimant completes the qualifying active duty military service. §59-2-1902(3)(a)
- ◆ Claimant may claim one exemption only in the year the application is filed. §59-2-1902(3)(b)
- ◆ Application must be filed annually for each SEPERATE period or qualifying active duty military service.
