

## Disaster Signal Ribbons

To facilitate a city disaster plan and block captain system, all residences should post their condition after a disaster by placing a colored signal ribbon, flag or sheet on their house in a place that is easily visible from the street. Block Captains and CERT teams will be dispatched to the places with the most critical needs first.

### **Signal Colors:**

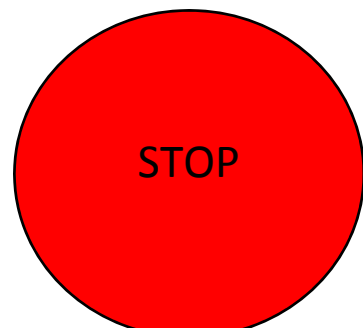
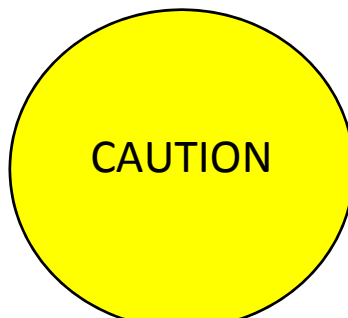
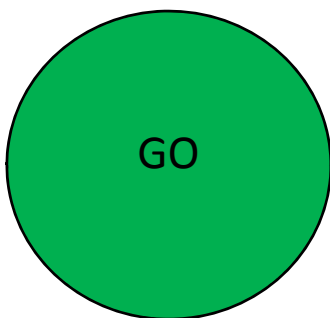
**Green-** *“GO” All is well! We are safe or we have evacuated our home*

**Yellow-** *“CAUTION” Delayed, Help is needed; It is NOT life threatening.*

**Red-** *“STOP” HELP! Immediate help or critical care is needed. Life threatening conditions.*

**Black-** *“DEAD” Deceased victims*

If all of your family is safe but the house is not, then take your family and 72 hour kits to the Incident Command Post for further instructions.
