



Recipe Of The Month

Stuffed Green Peppers



Ingredients:

- 2 green bell peppers
- 1/2 lb. ground turkey or beef
- 1/2 c. uncooked rice
- 1/4 c. onion peeled & chopped
- 3/4 c. tomato sauce—unsalted
- Salt & pepper to taste

Instructions:

- 1. Wash hands with soap and water
- 2. Cut around stems of peppers. Remove seeds and pulpy parts of peppers
- 3. Wash and cook peppers in boiling water for 5 minutes. Drain well.
- 4. In sauce pan, brown meat. Add rice, onion, 1/4 c. tomato sauce, salt and pepper.
- 5. Stuff each of the peppers and place in casserole dish.
- 6. Pour remaining tomato sauce over the peppers
- 7. Cover and bake for 30 minutes at 350 degrees.
